

INFORMATION FOR PARENTS

Our summer club programme aims to provide children with a range of different experiences during their holidays; this will be delivered through multiple activities.

It is our mission to provide a great experience to all of those to join our programme, promoting adventures that will become long-lasting memories. To carry out our mission we will use sporting, cultural and recreational activities.

DATE AND PLACE OF SUMMER CLUB ACTIVITIES

The summer club programme will run from 2 July to 10 August, from Monday to Friday, from 09.00 to 17.00 at Nobel International School, Porches.

CLUB ATTENDEES

Activities are aimed at children from the age of 6 up to 12.

ACTIVITIES

The club programme is structured according to a timetable and plan, which will include a beach and/or pool excursion in the morning and sports, recreation and artistic activities in the afternoon.

A weekly outing is planned, where children will have the opportunity to experience something new out of the school grounds – the aim is to broaden knowledge and to awaken new talents.

The teachers will be present at all times and will be responsible for the follow-up, control and well-being of the participants, providing an environment of friendship, familiarity and healthy, active living.

REGISTRATIONS

Bookings can be made up until 29 June 2018 and all paperwork may be delivered to the school office or to the teachers responsible for the programme – Alexandra Segueiro and José Nascimento.

PAYMENT

At the time of registration, please pay the amount:

Programme A (two weeks) – 150€

Programme B (month) – 300€

Programme C (6 weeks) – 450€

MEALS

Lunch is included in the programme but please send your child with a morning and afternoon snack.

CLOTHES AND ACCESSORIES

All children must wear sports clothes and carry a small backpack with a beach towel, flip-flops/beach shoes, cap, water and sunscreen.

Swimming trunks or bathing suits should be put on at home and will then be removed after the morning beach/pool activity.

Please bring a fresh change of clothes that can be left at school, if necessary.

Children should not carry any rings, mobile phones, electronic games or earphones/wires. If they do, the loss or damage of such items is the parent/guardian's responsibility.

TRANSPORT

Transport to the beach/pool or excursions off site is by a bus chartered by Nobel International School Algarve; EVA and expenses are included in the cost of the programme.

MEDICAL ASSISTENCE

If your child needs medication, all information regarding administering the medicine should be communicated to the teacher, especially for younger children.

In the case of an accident, the school has First Aid equipment and the teacher can proceed with a simple treatment. If the situation requires further care, the parent/guardian shall be informed immediately and the necessary steps will be taken in accordance with the regulations for this type of situation.

SCHOOL INSURANCE

All students at Nobel International School are covered by an insurance policy. The amounts covered by the policy are higher than the minimum values required by the law:

- Death or Permanent Disability – 24.940,00 Euros
- Hospital Treatment Expenses – 5.000,00 Euros
- Civil Liability during off-campus activities – 2.500,00 Euros

The school or the insurer will not be liable under any circumstances for amounts added to those listed above.
